

**Carney Round-Up Rodeo
Rodeo Reality Ride Barrel Racing
June 6-7, 2009**

**Nadeau Township Hall
US 41, Carney, Michigan**

This is a chance for barrel racers ages 12 and up to run barrels in an official rodeo! There are 16 slots open each day (8 in each rodeo performance). The performances will be on Saturday, June 6, 2009 at 5:00 pm (Central time) and Sunday, June 7, 2009 at 1:00 pm (Central time).

Rules

1. Male or female, age 12 and up.
2. Must have one year experience riding horses.
3. Must not have ridden in prior professional rodeo. If more than 16 entries for the two performances, entrants who have never ridden Dream Rides before will be chosen first.
4. Must furnish own horse with a negative Coggins test.
5. Must fill out rider application and pre-pay entry fee of \$25.00.
6. All horses must be trained to tie.
7. Each competitor can only enter one horse, and said horse cannot be shared by competitors.
8. Unnecessary roughness or abuse will not be permitted and shall be cause for forfeiture of competitor's entry fee.
9. Stallions can only be shown by 18-year-olds.
10. Western attire is to be worn in all events (barrel racing and parade). Anyone under the age of 18 is highly recommended to wear a helmet.
11. Pre-registration paper work has to be filled out and returned before May 24, 2009 with the \$25.00 entry fee and negative Coggins test.
12. Remember, we are only registering 16 riders. Only the first 16 entry forms received will be accepted. All others will be returned.
13. Riders will be expected to carry a flag in the Wild West Parade and on the day of their performance.
14. 2009 Rodeo Reality Ride participant check list:
 - a. Approved helmet (if under 18 years of age) or western hat
 - b. Long-sleeved shirt (Western and buttoned to the top)
 - c. Full length pants and belt
 - d. Cowboy boots (riding boots with heel)
 - e. Breast collar & throat latch
 - f. Continuous reins
 - g. Negative Coggins test
