**CONCESSION INFORMATION**

We require \$50.00 for up to 20 feet of outdoor frontage, and \$100.00 for indoor concession space, unless there are more than four vendors, in which case the indoor price will be prorated. There will also be 10% of gross concession sales required and 30% of gross amusement sales required. (Amusement includes dunk tanks, air slides, mechanical bull, etc.) Balance due on sales within 30 days of rodeo completion. Food vendors have exclusive rights on a first-come, first-served basis. ALL VENDORS will be required to operate and maintain booths from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Central time) on Saturday, June 6, and from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Central time) on Sunday, June 7. Vendors are welcome to open Sunday morning due to activities on the grounds, but it is not mandatory until 1:00 p.m. Set-up on June 5 is encouraged, but not required. Vendors must be set up no later than 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 6.

GENERAL LIABILITY insurance will be required to be on file prior to any set-up, with a \$300,000 minimum. Vendors and exhibitors agree to not hold Carney Round-Up Rodeo Committee, representatives of the rodeo, or co-sponsoring organizations responsible for property damage or loss, personal injury, or death occurring while being part of the Carney Round-Up Rodeo. Exhibitors agree to assume liability for property damage, personal injury or death occurring within or outside of the exhibit space from causes which originate within the exhibit space. This event is governed by the Michigan Equine Liability Act.

REFUNDS: Cancellations prior to May 6, 2009 will receive a full refund. After May 6, a credit will be issued for next year's rodeo.

SECURITY: We strongly suggest you take adequate steps to avoid theft or damage to your property. There will be a night watchman on the rodeo grounds, but the rodeo will not be responsible for property and merchandise of exhibitors and concessionaries.

Two complimentary weekend passes will be included for each vendor or exhibitor space. Pets are not allowed on the rodeo grounds except on a leash in the campground area. Rustic camping is available for \$10.00.

Carney Round-Up Rodeo reserves the right to cancel or restrict exhibits which, because of noise, methods, materials, or for any reason become objectionable, problematic, or, in the opinion of the Carney Round-Up Rodeo, detract from the general character of the exhibit as a whole. In the event of such restriction or cancellation, Carney Round-Up Rodeo is not liable for any refund or other exhibit expenses.
